Charter

This charter addresses the roles and responsibilities of the California Fire Alliance.

Vision

Californians, and all levels of government, will share responsibility and work together to create fire safe communities and healthy ecosystems.

Mission

Successful interagency/public collaboration that protects and enhances the quality of life threatened by wildfire.

Strategies

The California Fire Alliance, through its members, will work with residents, property owners, partners and stakeholders in the wildland urban interface to provide technical and financial assistance as appropriate under the authorities granted to it by law and regulation. Although Alliance members may work with the public directly, the Alliance works to:

- Collaborate with members and with stakeholder partners to coordinate actions, financial resources, and technical assistance to pursue firefighter and public safety, fire safe communities and healthy wildland ecosystems.
- Establish priorities and opportunities for joint actions to collect information, maintain records, monitor progress, and account for Alliance resources used.
- Maintain awareness of social, economic, and technological advances; assess how these changes influence wildfire threats; and inform decision makers how to decrease wildfire threats and promote healthy wildland ecosystems.
